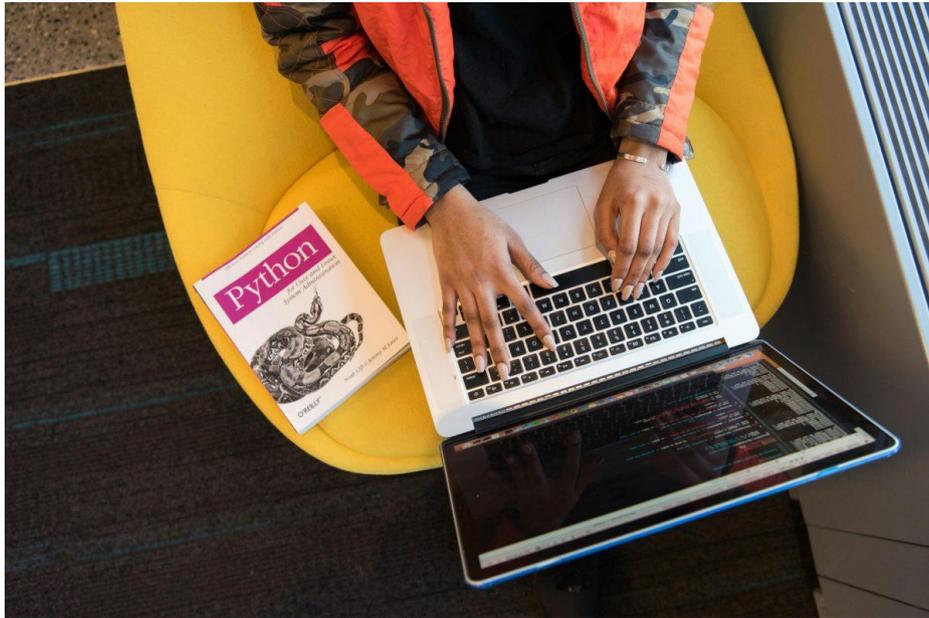

AI Metascience Fellowships

A new UK government-funded fellowship programme will see researchers explore how AI can change the way we conduct research and support the daily work of scientists. Applicants close on the 10th April 2025 with up to £260,000 in funding per project available.
